The 2022 COOCVE Election Committee is beginning the task of preparing for the Elections that will be held on Tuesday, January 18, 2022. The Election Candidates' Forum will take place on Thursday, January 6, 2022. Any Building President wanting to change or add a voting COOCVE Director must submit names to COOCVE@coocve.com or to the COOCVE Office by Tuesday, December 1, 2021. Please remember, COOCVE directors are those who were appointed by the building President for the year 2021 not 2022.

Information/Guidelines and Application Forms will be available for pick up at the Master Management Office and the Staff Office in the Clubhouse as of November 1st. Forms will also be available on the COOCVE.com website by October 15th.

The following are positions to be voted on in 2022:

- CenClub Board has two (2) open positions; each will serve a three-year term.
- Master Management Board has three (3) open positions; each will serve a three-year term.
- COOCVE Executive Board has the following open positions; each will serve a two-year term: President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Treasurer, Controller, Sargent-at-Arms, and Secretary.

Candidates may apply for a position on one Board only:

CenClub Board oversees the professional staff that is responsible for, and administers, the CVE recreation facilities, including the Clubhouse.

Master Management Board oversees the professional staff responsible for providing Community Services, acting similar to a Public Works Department. This includes items such as landscaping, streetlights, lakes, irrigation, sanitation, etc. in the common areas only.

COOCVE (Condominium Owners Organization of Century Village East) works with all 253 Building Associations to educate Condo Boards and residents of the 8,508 units about rights and responsibilities. It works with Buildings and management entities to help solve common problems and to provide residents a forum to discuss common issues.
